As the full Senate begins debating the 2007 Farm Bill, I ask, on behalf of the members of the National Association of Wheat Growers, that you oppose any attempt to undermine the hard work and delicate compromises struck by the Committee on Finance in their “Heartland, Habitat, Harvest and Horticulture Act of 2007,” which will be taken up as part of the farm bill package, by voting to shift funds out of this package on the Senate floor.

Wheat growers across the country have experienced severe droughts, fires, floods and freezes over the last several years and believe that the supplemental assistance provided by the “Heartland, Habitat, Harvest and Horticulture Act of 2007” would help offset the future needs of growers during difficult times like these.

Again, I would ask that you oppose any effort to weaken this carefully crafted legislation.
